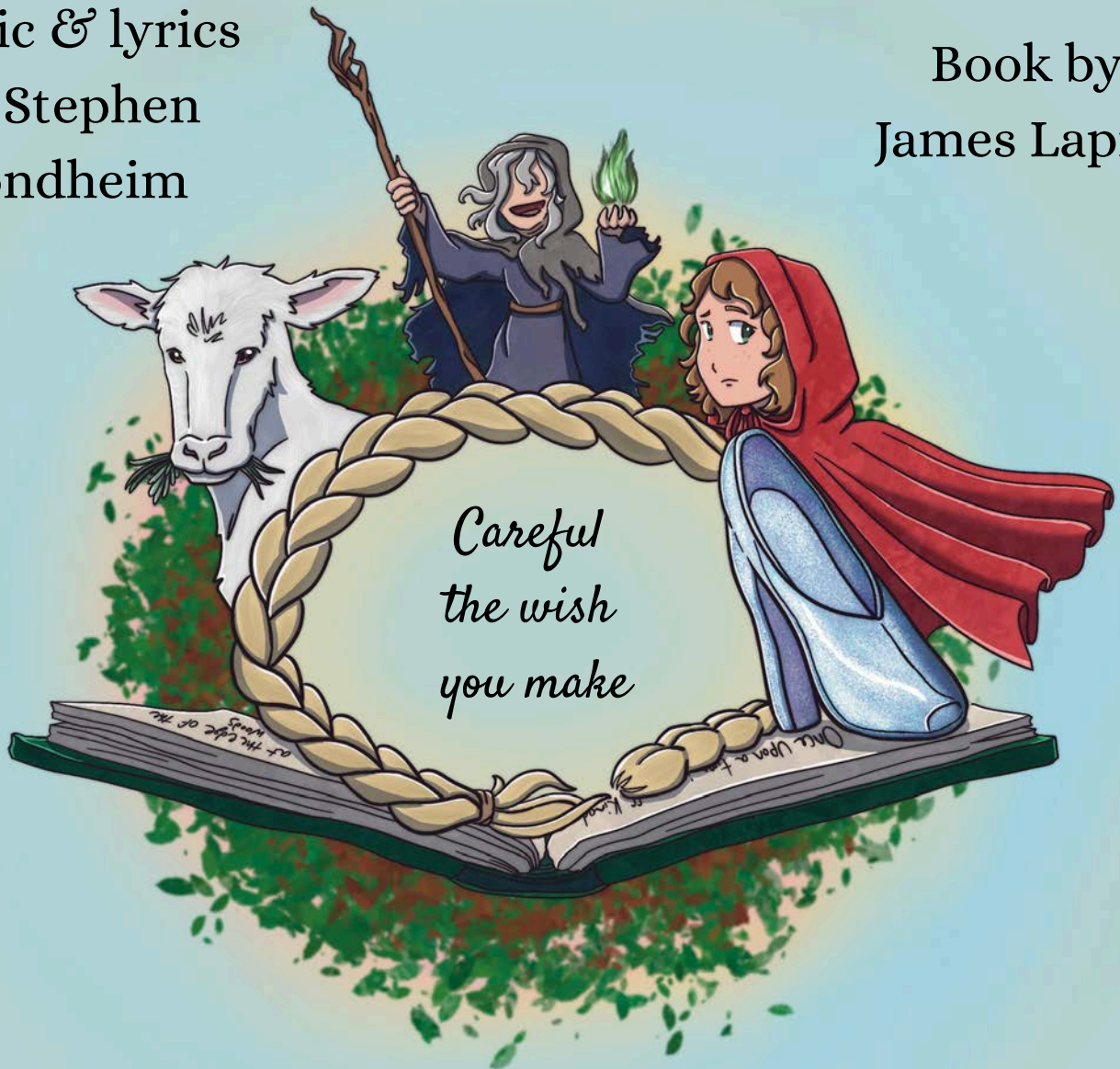

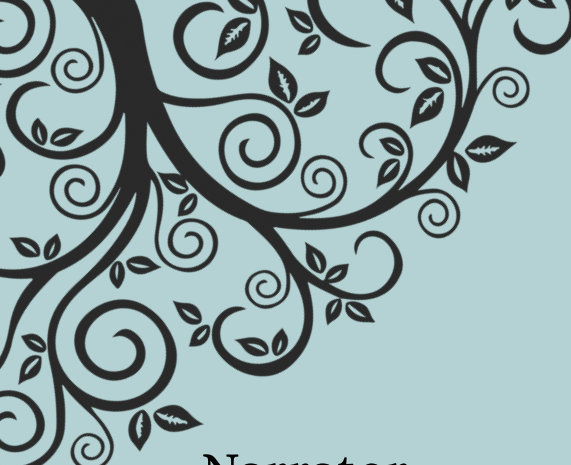

Cinderella

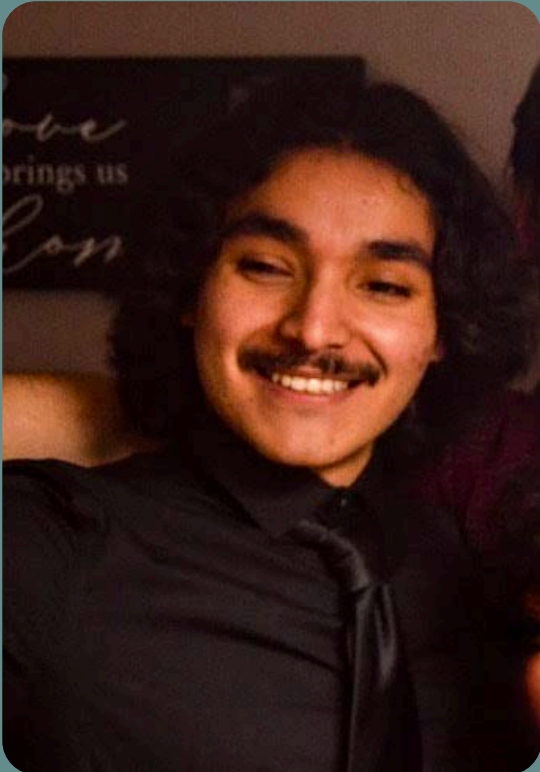

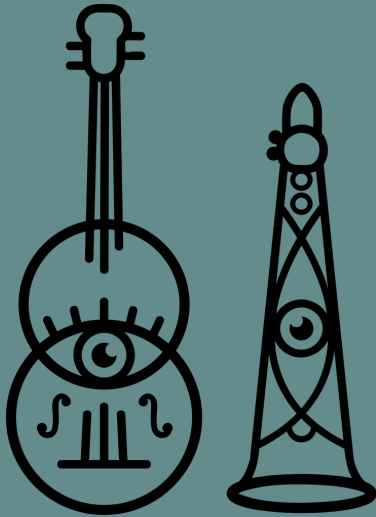
